



LOS DIABLOS MÁS DIABLOS

When the Diablos Rojos turned 65 in 2005, Don Alfredo Harp Helú announced the creation of a Hall of Fame for the Novena Escarlata, despite the absence of a permanent location to honor its members. Seven legends were selected to be part of the inaugural class.

Ten years later, in 2015, six more figures were inducted into the Marabunta Roja's immortality, bringing the total number of honored individuals to 13.

Without planning it that way, the intangible Hall of Fame gave rise to what is now the Devils Museum, where this hall was established, named "The Most Devilish Devils." This name maintains the spirit of the original idea while avoiding confusion with the beautiful venue in Monterrey.

To select the first two generations, a committee was formed to evaluate the merits of each candidate and continue assessing and choosing future members of the Diablos más Diablos—those who will share the throne with the truly great.

This select group includes players, managers, executives, journalists, and individuals whose contributions to the organization are outstanding.
