Also known as a traje, our first uniforms were made by the team's co-founder and first manager, Don Ernesto Carmona, who owned a successful sporting goods store located in Mexico City Downtown.

The “Pandilla Escarlata” has not escaped the evolution of fabrics, styles, designs, and logos; however, the primary color has always been blood red—originally chosen by Don Ernesto Carmona, who, through his experience in sports marketing, observed that crimson uniforms were the most requested.

For fans, the launch of the new uniforms is one of the most important dates of the year, while for team members, it remains a ritual to admire each piece of clothing they wear on the field.
